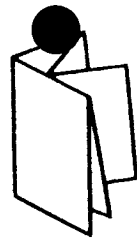

Certification

The council Exploring training chairman must approve all applications. Adults must be approved by the Advisor, committee chairman, or council service team chairman.

- Plan and conduct a post parents' night program.
- Plan and conduct a firstnighter program.
- Plan and conduct a post handicap awareness program.

- Attend at least two Explorer officers' association (EOA) meetings.
- Attend an EOA training session (or its equivalent).
- Attend at least two council Exploring committee meetings or service team meetings.
- Participate in a post officers' seminar.
- Attend an Explorer program conference or similar council meeting.
- Attend at least two planning sessions for a council EOA or specialty association activity.
- Participate in a councilwide civic service project.
- Attend an area Exploring conference.
- Help with the council sustaining membership enrollment.

- For all adults registered in Exploring except the Advisor and service team.**
- Training**
- Complete the sessions outlined in *Explorer Leader Basic Training*.
- Tenure**
- Complete 3 years' tenure registered in any adult capacity in Exploring.
- Performance**
- Do any seven of the following:
- Attend a minimum of two Advisors' meetings (or council equivalent) during the 3 years.
 - Attend the council Exploring service team conference.

EXPLORING TRAINING AWARD

EXPLORER ADVISOR'S KEY

- Training**
- Complete the sessions outlined in *Explorer Leader Basic Training*.
 - Conduct the post officers' seminar as outlined in *Explorer Leader Handbook*.
 - Attend an Explorer program conference or similar council meeting with the post's elected officers.
 - Attend a minimum of four quarterly Advisors' meetings (or council equivalent) during the 3 years.
- Tenure**
- Complete 3 years of registered tenure as an Explorer Advisor within a 5-year period.

Performance

At least twice during the 3-year period serve as the Advisor of a post earning the National Quality Unit Award or its equivalent.

Certification

The post committee chairman and service team member must approve the Advisor's application for a key.

EXPLORING SERVICE TEAM KEY

- Training**
- Complete the sessions outlined in *Explorer Leader Basic Training*.
 - Attend the council Exploring service team conference or training session.
 - Attend an Explorer program conference or similar council meeting with his or her assigned posts or ships.
- Tenure**
- Complete 3 years of registered tenure as an Exploring service team member within a 5-year period.

Performance

Each assigned unit must earn the National Quality Unit Award or its equivalent at least once during the 3-year period. (If assigned more than four units, then at least half must earn the award.)

Certification

The council Exploring service team chairman must approve the service team member's application for a key.
